## ACCESS RULES

- Registered persons are requested to arrive at the visitors' entrance (Bundesterrasse side) at least 30 minutes before the tour is due to begin to allow sufficient time for the required ID and security check. Wheelchair and wheeled walker users are requested to use the entrance on the Bundesplatz side. Please ring the bell.
- The ticket (printed out or on your smartphone/tablet) must be presented to the security staff. Only as many people as are stated on the ticket will be admitted. Visitors arriving late will not be granted access.
- All visitors from the age of 16 are subject to an identity check and are required to present an official ID document to security staff. Acceptable forms of photo ID are: passport, identity card (from CH and EU states), driving licence (from CH and EU states), Swiss foreign nationals identity card, FDFA legitimization card, federal ID card. Visitors then undergo security screening by walking through a metal detector and passing their belongings through an x-ray device.
- Liquids are not permitted, with the exception of medicines and baby food/special food preparations.
- Visitors may each bring one item of luggage no larger than L 41cm x W 31cm x H 10cm. A small handbag no larger than 21cm x 15cm (C5 format) is permitted on the galleries of the National Council and the Council of States. Lockers are available at the visitors' entrance (after the security check).
- Only folding prams that fit through the revolving door can be brought into the building.
- Visitors to the Parliament Building are expected to dress appropriately and behave in a befitting manner.
- Photography (no flash) is allowed inside the building but is not permitted from the galleries. Filming is not permitted at any time. Mobile phones must be muted.
